

HOW TO GET TO WEE JASPER

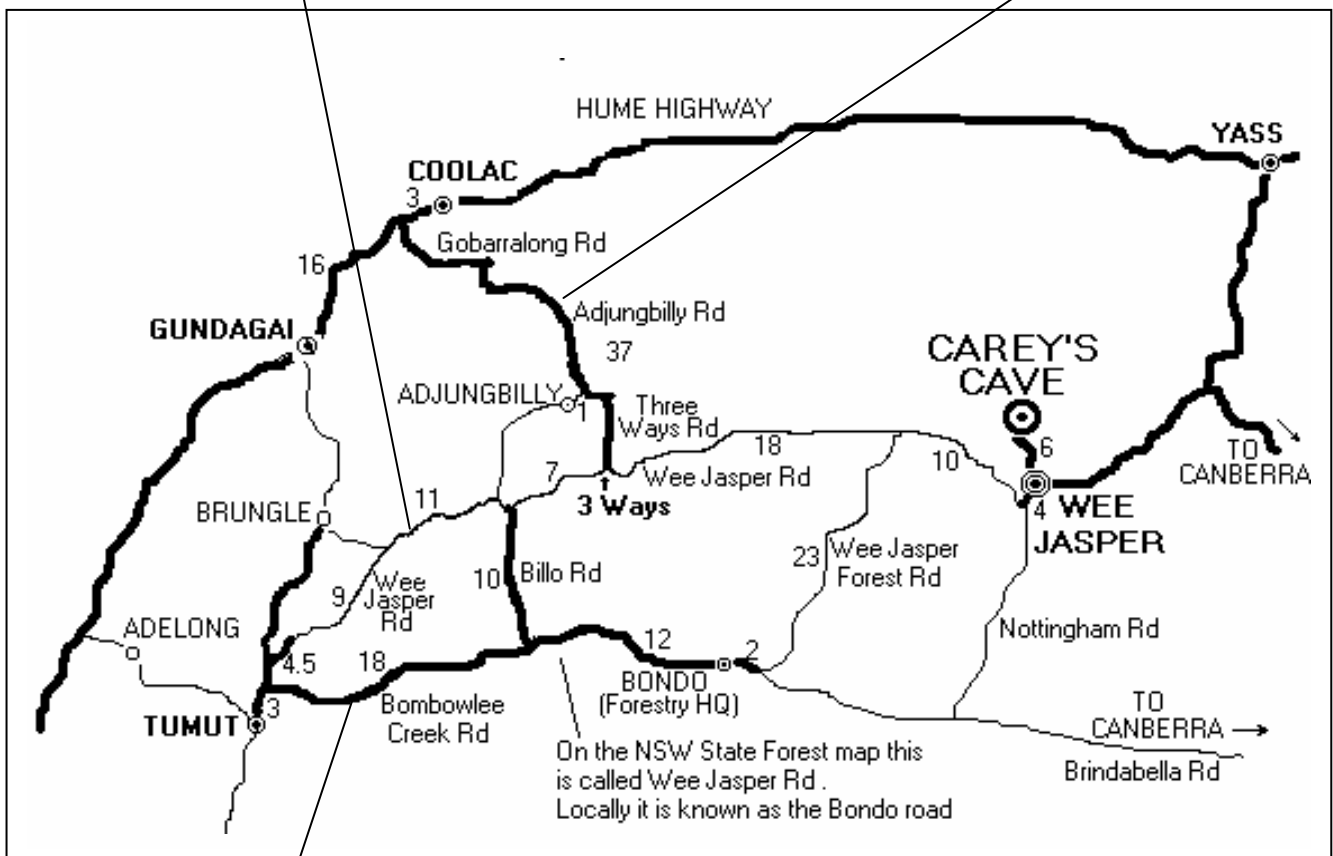
THE ROADS TO WEE JASPER FROM GUNDAGAI & TUMUT

ROUTE 2: FROM TUMUT VIA WEE JASPER RD (TOURIST DRIVE 7)

Distance: 68 km
Road conditions: Mostly unsealed.
7.5 km sealed to past Brungle Rd
20 km unsealed to Billo Rd
39 km unsealed to Wee Jasper
Travelling time: 75 mins

ROUTE 1: FROM HUME HIGHWAY VIA ADJUNGBILLY RD

Distance : Hume Highway – 3 Ways 37 km
3 Ways - Wee Jasper 33 km
Road conditions: Sealed road to 3 Ways
Gravel from 3 Ways to Wee Jasper usually in good condition.
Travelling time: Highway – 3 Ways 30 mins
3 Ways - Wee Jasper 40 mins



ROUTE 3: FROM TUMUT VIA BILLO RD

ROUTE 4: FROM TUMUT VIA BONDO

Distance: 68 km
Road conditions: 31 km sealed via Billo
39 km unsealed to WJ
35 km sealed via Bondo
37 km unsealed to WJ
Travelling time: 75 mins

PLEASE NOTE: Road conditions & travelling times will depend on weather and vehicle.

SUMMARY OF DIFFERENT ROUTES

ROUTE 1: FROM GUNDAGAI VIA ADJUNGBILLY RD.

The most convenient route if travelling from Gundagai or Coolac. Turn south onto Gobarralong Rd which goes over the Murrumbidgee River. Becomes Adjungbilly Rd which winds up through picturesque grazing country. The small village of Adjungbilly is about 1 km off to one side of this route. This road meets Wee Jasper Rd at 3 Ways (though it is not identified as such on older road maps.)

FROM 3 WAYS TO WEE JASPER. Turn left onto this gravel road, the first 10 km gently winds through grazing land, usually good surface. Yass Shire boundary, road is a bit narrower, winding through bushland down to the Wee Jasper valley. This section is OK for trailer but not recommended for a larger caravan. On the last few kms to WJ there are a number of blind corners so travel these very slowly on your own side of the road. The road emerges at Fitzpatrick Trackhead (serving the Hume and Hovell Walking Track).

Turning left here onto the sealed road will take you to the Wee Jasper village and also on to Carey's Cave.

The gravel road (Nottingham Rd) which continues from the Trackhead goes straight up the valley, passing several pretty camping/picnic areas and carries on to the Brindabella Rd.

ROUTE 2: FROM TUMUT VIA WEE JASPER RD (KNOWN LOCALLY AS THE WYANGLE RD ROUTE)

This is Tourist Drive 7 and therefore follows the Shire roads from Tumut to Yass (also mostly unsealed to Wee Jasper).

Follow the #7 signs out from Tumut, on up to Billo Rd, turn right then left onto the Wee Jasper road. This will take you through Tumorrroma (don't blink) and on up to 3 Ways. Directions from there as above.

ROUTE 3: FROM TUMUT VIA BILLO RD

Follow first bit of Tourist Drive 7 but 3 kms from Tumut turn right onto Bombowlee Creek Rd (sign says to Canberra).

Stay on this sealed road up the hills till you meet Billo Rd on your left. Turn onto Billo Rd and follow till end of bitumen.

Turn right onto Wee Jasper road (signposted). Directions from there as above. **THIS IS PROBABLY THE BEST ROUTE TUMUT – WEE JASPER.**

ROUTE 4: FROM TUMUT VIA BONDO

As for ROUTE 3 however don't turn onto Billo Rd, stay on through Bondo, turn left (at end of bitumen) and follow to WJ Rd. Turn right and follow down to valley. Directions from there as above. Mostly forestry road so you may meet logging trucks on this road.
